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### 1.0 The Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR)

1.01 Is the authority controlling the transport of radioactive material (Class 7 dangerous goods) by road, rail and inland waterways within the United Kingdom

1.02 This role is overseen within ONR by the Transport Competent Authority team with the support of suitably qualified inspectors.

1.03 ONR also provides advice and guidance to other transport regulators for the movement of radioactive material in by sea and air within the United Kingdom.

1.04 The movement of radioactive material is wide ranging and includes

- a) Flasks carrying spent nuclear fuel from operating and decommissioned nuclear reactors,
- b) Radio-pharmaceuticals needed for hospitals,
- c) Sealed radioactive sources needed in the construction industry and,
- d) For instance, in non-destructive testing applications on North Sea oil rigs.

1.05 ONR engages with:

- a) Other transport regulators and government departments
- b) industry bodies and specialists
- c) International bodies and groups
- d) Industry bodies and specialists

### 2.0 Bet and 645 Services Actions to Meet ONR Requirements

2.01 All BET and 645 Services drivers and traffic controllers involved with transporting radioactive materials must :-

- a) Read every year the ONR publication Transporting radioactive material - Guidance on radiation and contamination monitoring requirements, and determining a Transport Index (Attached to this Procedure)
- b) Have successfully completed a training course on Transporting radioactive materials
- c) Successfully complete a review of the training (every year or when a radioactive material movement is undertaken if no such work is undertaken in the yearly period)
- d) A suitably qualified member of staff (i.e. - traffic controller) must be involved with the contract review when Transporting radio active materials job is undertaken
- e) A review of activities in this area is reported to each BET/645 Services Management Review
- f) Transporting radio active materials activities are audited as part of our Internal Audit Procedures

### 3.0 BET and 645 Services Actions Outside the United Kingdom

- a) We do not currently operate the transportation of radioactive materials outside the United Kingdom
